

Academic Abstracts - Send in your abstracts for the FIN3R Symposium.

We invite you to submit an abstract on the application of **3Rs** in your work which will be judged for the FIN3R symposium award¹.

Please submit the following:

- An abstract which covers a topic on replacement, reduction, or refinement strategies that you have employed or developed in your work.
- The abstract should be approximately 200-300 words long (with a 500 word limit).
- The authors are required to attend the FIN3R symposium in person in Kuopio, Finland.
- Please include the author's names and affiliations and underline the presenting author's name.
- No AI, LLM's, or GenAI can be used for anything other than language checking.
- Authors of the selected abstracts will be notified by email to give a short oral presentation of their work at the FIN3R symposium. They will receive a certificate of presenting.
- Selected abstracts will be requested to provide the full protocols to be published in a protocol publication.
- Chosen abstracts will be provided with a certificate prize.

Abstract Deadline: 28 September 2026, 16:00 Eastern European Time.
